Bids must be sealed in an envelope clearly marked with the bid number and title given above, and placed in the **bid box entrance of !Kheis Municipal Building, 97 Oranje Street , Grobblershoop**, on or before the mentioned time and latest date. Telephonic, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted. Bids must remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date of the bid. !Kheis Local Municipality reserves its right to extend the validity period, should you not be willing to hold your bid valid in all respects for further period as requested, it will lapse on expiry of the current validity period.

Bids will be opened on the same day at the Supply Chain Management Section at 11h00. Late or unmarked bids will not be considered.

A compulsory briefing meeting will be held on 11 August 2017 at 11h00 in the Council Chambers, at !Kheis Municipality in Grobblershoop.

Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued.

Bids will be evaluated according to the **80/20** preference points system. The bids are subject to the Council Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017.

Prequalification criteria

Only bidders meeting the following criteria may tender. Bidders not complying are unacceptable.

Respondents with a minimum BBBEE status level of Level Two (2)

Exempted Micro Enterprises (EMEs) or SME(s)

Head office within Norther Cape Province

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.
